Some activities included this year are: 5K run walk, canoeing wetlands, demonstrations of trapping and hunting techniques, birding hikes, habitat programs, shooting with rifles and bows, and much more. The family day booths and activities will begin at 10:00AM and run until 3:00 PM. Squaw Creek National Wildlife Refuge is located 5 miles south of Mound City, Missouri traveling from Interstate-29 to Exit 79 then on Highway 159 South.

The Friends of Squaw Creek National Wildlife Refuge are hosting the Dusty Dash 5K Run/Walk on Saturday, October 13 with registration at 8 A-M and the run starting at 9 A-M. The registration is being held in the refuge auto tour parking lot at 8:00 A-M and the run starts at 9A-M.
