Auburn City Council to Discuss Future of Law Enforcement Monday Night (KLZA) The Auburn City Council will meet in special session Monday evening at 7 o'clock at City Hall.

Preliminary numbers indicated the City of Auburn could save just over \$120,000 for the next budget year by contracting for law enforcement coverage with the Nemaha County Sheriff's Department.
