Best Management Practice (BMP) Auction Deadline

Producers in the Delaware River Watershed have until <u>September 1, 2013</u> to apply for **Best Management Practice (BMP) Auction** funding available through Delaware River WRAPS with assistance from K-State Research & Extension. A variety of cropland, livestock and gully-control practices are eligible for the funding.

A **BMP Auction** operates like a reverse auction where producers offer to install a practice for a pre-determined price that they offer in the form of a bid. Successful "bidders" receive up to **70% cost-share (\$7,500 maximum)** for eligible practices installed in targeted areas of the watershed.

All applications must be received by the Sept. 1 deadline, and will be evaluated shortly thereafter. Funding decisions are based on water quality benefits received per dollar invested. Funding is granted to the most efficient practices that will be installed in targeted areas of the watershed.
