

School Year Begins Wednesday for Pawnee City Students

(KTNC) - The first day of class for Pawnee City students is Wednesday, with a noon dismissal that day. The normal school day remains the same as last year, with classes beginning at 8:10 a.m. and dismissing at 3:40 p.m. Classes will dismiss at 2:00 p.m. on Fridays for staff development.

School lunch prices in Pawnee City are \$2.30 for Pre-Kindergarten through 6th grade and \$2.50 for grades seven through 12. Breakfast costs \$1.55 for all grades.

The Pawnee City School will host an open house at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday. Seventh grade orientation will be held at the same time. The “boot camp” for computer checkout will be held at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday.
