The District winner will compete at the area contest for cash prizes in the amount of \$250 for the first place winner, \$150 cash for second place and third place will receive \$100. The area winner will compete in the State contest for scholarships which can be used at an accredited school or training institution of the winner's choice. First place will be awarded a \$500 scholarship and second place will receive a \$250 scholarship.

As an incentive for teachers to get their students to participate a \$25 gift card will be presented to the sponsoring teacher of the 1st place district winner.
