The Northwest Missouri State University Department of Fine and Performing Arts begins its 2013-2014 main stage series this week with its annual Freshman/Transfer Showcase.

This year's showcase, "New Beginnings," will play Wednesday, Oct. 2, through Sunday, Oct. 6, in the Studio Theater at the Ron Houston Center for the Performing Arts. Performances begin at 7:30 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday in addition to matinees at 4 p.m. Saturday and 2 p.m. Sunday.
