

Finalists for Pawnee City Superintendent Position Revealed

The fourth candidate to be interviewed is Mike Williams. Williams is currently the Superintendent at Maywood Public Schools, Maywood, Nebraska. Williams has four years experience as a Superintendent and a dozen years experience as a Principal or Assistant Principal.
